Types of Wetlands

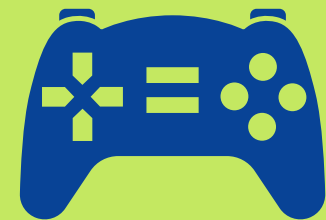
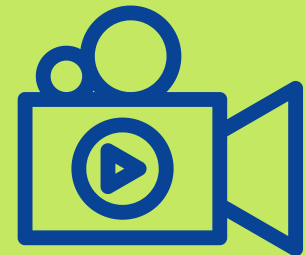
The Aquarium at Cairns

Wetlands may be natural or artificial and the water within a wetland may be static or flowing, fresh, brackish or saline. There are even underground wetlands.





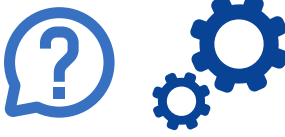
